Purpose of the Visit

The objective of the visit is to provide us an insight regarding internal working of NSIC and to be aware of different opportunities within the industry as well as to allow us to see the working of different machinery and to explore classroom concepts with professionals. Activities Conducted

Following are the various types of machinery and projects which we have observed during the visit:-

- **Exercise Book Machinery**, production capacity/annum-600 thousand exercise books of 64 pages; Investment required up to Rs. 28.50 Lakh.
- **Bakery Project**, production capacity/annum-9 lakh breads of 400 grams; Investment required up to Rs. 29 Lakh.
- **Nylon Socks Machinery**, production capacity/annum-30,000 Dozen Pairs; Investment required up to Rs. 110 Lakh.
- **Paper Napkin Machinery**, production capacity/annum-300 M.T.; Investment required up to Rs. 102 Lakh.
